In Open Discussion, Board members spoke positively about the spring high school musical, Fiddler on the Roof; Wendy Minten commented that GIC is interested in participating in adding to the elementary playground equipment; and, Pfeifer commented that John Sawyer believed that a softball field project would not be expensive or extensive.
