Through a special program, Door County Public Health will be providing **FREE** Influenza vaccine to **any student in grades 6 -12, regardless of insurance status.**

The clinic is scheduled for Tuesday, October 22nd.

To participate: Return completed Consent to Receive Vaccine form to school by Friday, October 11th.

Influenza (flu) vaccine

Protects against different strains of seasonal influenza. A yearly dose is recommended for everyone 6 months of age and older.

We are able to provide Injectable and Nasal Mist Flu Vaccine this year.
